History

Caring Health Center (CHC), a Federally Qualified Health Center, was created in Springfield's South End in 1995 to fill the demand for high quality, affordable healthcare for all area residents. We believe that *Health is the Heart of our Community*. Keeping that heart beating requires extending a helping hand to people who need it most. Veterans, the elderly, the young, the economically disadvantaged and people of all languages, races, and beliefs.

At CHC we believe that no one should ever have to suffer from a lack of care. The provision of evidence-based healthcare requires an understanding of all issues related to the well-being of the patients we serve. CHC makes comprehensive care available to all. Removing barriers to healthcare is one of our top priorities.

Toward that end, CHC provides translation services in dozens of languages, free patient transportation, and pharmacy delivery, assistance obtaining basic living essentials, WIC, and a health navigation team that helps connect patients to insurance. CHC is also the largest refugee healthcare service provider in the region. We are firmly committed to expanding healthcare services throughout Western Massachusetts. We provide healthcare services through our collaborators and partners — the Springfield Rescue Mission and Hampden County Sheriff's office as well.

As we reflect on a milestone year for Caring Health Center, I am deeply proud and grateful for all that we—our dedicated staff, valued partners, and trusted collaborators—have accomplished together. Our 30th anniversary stands as a testament to three decades of commitment to improving health and well-being across Western Massachusetts. With multiple locations, we are removing barriers and increasing access for individuals and families throughout our region.

We expanded our pharmacy services by opening a new location at 1235 Boston Road, alongside our flagship at 1049 Main Street. CHC pharmacies offer free delivery six days a week throughout Greater Springfield. We are also investing in the future of healthcare through the Tania M. Barber Learning Institute. This initiative offers on-the-job training and career pathways, equipping community members to grow, lead, and serve. These efforts strengthen our workforce and enhance the long-term sustainability and cultural responsiveness of care. Over the past year, our services have grown, allowing us to expand our impact across diverse populations. This progress reaffirms our belief that accessible, compassionate care transforms lives and strengthens communities. Again, these achievements are possible because of our dedicated staff, the trust of our patients, and the support of our partners and stakeholders. Who We Serve

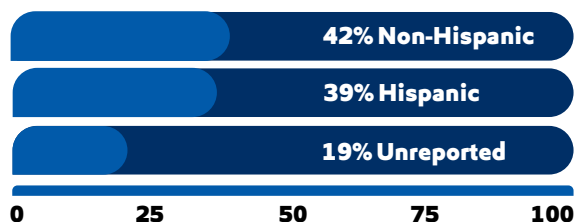
For over 30 years, Caring Health Center (CHC) has served the people of Western Massachusetts. Operating from multiple Springfield locations and offering mobile and transportation services, CHC delivers evidence-based healthcare to a diverse community, including the elderly, families, veterans, immigrants, and those facing economic challenges. We provide medical, behavioral health, dental, and nutritional counseling.

Our commitment remains that everyone deserves affordable, accessible, quality healthcare, regardless of ethnicity, economic status, or beliefs. In 2025, nearly 22,000 patients relied on us for adult and pediatric primary care, including physicals, immunizations, and treatment of acute and chronic illnesses. We also delivered preventative and restorative dental care during 20,054 patient visits.

Our behavioral health team provides in-person and virtual individual and group therapy, as well as psychiatric medication management. CHC remains a leader in health center-led research.

In collaboration with partners such as Harvard University, the University of Arizona, the University of Massachusetts Amherst, and OCHIN, we have developed a model for integrated, sustainable research that translates into improvements in public health and clinical practice within a federally qualified health center.

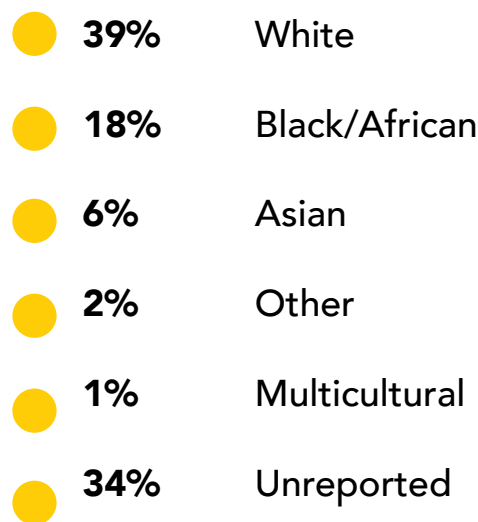

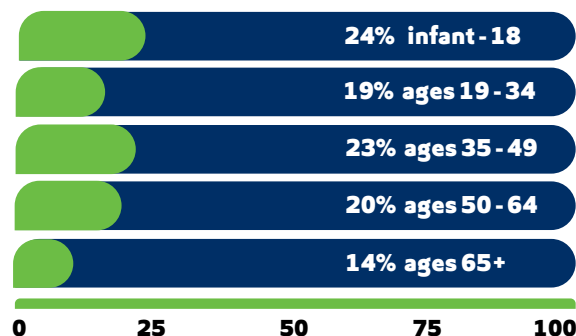

Community Impact

Our Women, Infants, & Children (WIC) program supported 3,332 families through nutrition education, access to healthy foods, breastfeeding assistance, and community referrals. WIC families redeemed \$3.5 million in food benefits at 14 locally approved stores.



CHC's Office of Workforce Development and the Tania M. Barber Learning Institute provided job training, professional development classes, and educational seminars for 294 participants in 2025.



Conducted 15,372 virtual visits across medical, dental, behavioral health, and nutrition services.



- **Provided gynecology, sexual and reproductive health, and family planning services during 4,710 clinical visits for 3,734 patients.**
- **147 patients living with HIV received ongoing medical care and social support.**
- **Our pharmacy delivered over 15,000 prescriptions free of charge to patients.**
- **21,828 individuals benefited from comprehensive primary care, dental, behavioral health, and substance use services.**
- **275 patients participated in evidence-based wellness programs, including nutrition, chronic disease and diabetes self-management, self-monitored blood pressure, and asthma home visits.**
- **Enrollment Navigators provided 4,639 individual assists to help Western Massachusetts residents maintain health and nutrition benefits, including 1,992 applications and 3,721 enrollments in health insurance plans and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP).**
- **1,454 individuals with substance use disorders received integrated treatment plans tailored to their needs through coordinated primary care and behavioral health treatment. Of these, 129 individuals received medication-assisted treatment.**
- **Healthcare services were delivered without language barriers, with interpretation in 76 languages and translation in 11 languages. The most common languages include Spanish, Arabic, Vietnamese, Russian, and Swahili.**
- **1,437 patients were diagnosed with asthma in 2025.**
- **8,057 free rides were provided to patients in medical, dental, and behavioral health in 2025.**

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

We believe comprehensive, integrated care in a respectful, non-judgmental environment empowers each person to progress at their own pace. We achieve this through trauma-informed, strength-based interventions for all seeking support. Services include:

FAMILY PLANNING & REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

Our specially trained clinicians offer a full range of family planning and reproductive health services in a supportive, non-judgmental environment. Patients of any age can receive services confidentially and without parental consent, including:

- Pregnancy Testing and Options Counseling
- Gynecological and Breast Exams
- Pre-Conception and Fertility Counseling
- Cervical Cancer Screening
- HPV Vaccination
- STI Counseling, Testing & Treatment

WELLNESS CENTER

Our Wellness Center offers free, group-based physical activity classes to promote cardiovascular health. We also provide workshops in nutrition, cooking demonstrations, chronic disease prevention, stress reduction, and more.

PHARMACY

Our pharmacy supplies prescriptions and over-the-counter products, offering convenience for patients and the public. We also provide free pharmacy delivery.

DIABETES CLINIC

Our Diabetes Clinic is dedicated to improving care for patients living with diabetes. We focus on blood glucose control, medication management, patient education, and completion of necessary testing.

HIV SUPPORT SERVICES

We provide comprehensive programs to support the medical and social needs of patients living with HIV/AIDS. Individualized case management services include:

- Infectious Disease
- Specialist Consultations
- Enrollment in HIV Drug Assistance Program (HDAP)
- Medication Adherence Support
- Harm Reduction Counseling
- Partner Prevention (PrEP)
- Social Support Services

HEALTH INSURANCE ENROLLMENT

Our Health Insurance Navigators help individuals and families find affordable health coverage through the Massachusetts Health Connector, ConnectorCare, MassHealth, and Health Safety Net. We assist with understanding plan options, submitting applications, and obtaining financial assistance.

WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN (W.I.C.)

WIC helps keep pregnant and breastfeeding women and children healthy by providing personalized nutrition counseling, free healthy food, medical referrals, and other resources.

REFUGEE HEALTH ASSESSMENTS

We offer comprehensive initial and follow-up screening and care coordination for newly arriving refugees, removing financial and administrative barriers to early medical and diagnostic services.

Patient Shuttles & Prescription Delivery

Free patient transportation and prescription delivery are two ways Caring Health Center removes barriers to affordable, quality healthcare. CHC provides daily transportation for patient appointments, offering 8,057 free rides in 2025. Unlike providers who outsource, our drivers are CHC employees familiar with our organization and services. Laura Taylor, Vice President of Patient Operations and Experiences, said, “Our drivers are familiar faces. It provides security and peace of mind.”

In 2025, CHC delivered over 15,000 prescriptions at no additional charge, according to Chief Pharmacy Officer Chetan Gohil. Prescription deliveries are available Monday through Saturday, with drivers making up to 20 stops daily within a 10-mile radius of our flagship facility at 1049 Main St. Currently, about 500 registered customers benefit from this service, which is available to both CHC patients and the broader community.

“Medication adherence is a deep concern,” said Chetan Gohil, chief pharmacy officer at Caring Health Center. “Some patients do not take prescribed medications for a number of reasons, including cost and accessibility.” The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has estimated that non-adherence causes 30 to 50 percent of chronic disease treatment failures and 125,000 deaths in the U.S. annually.



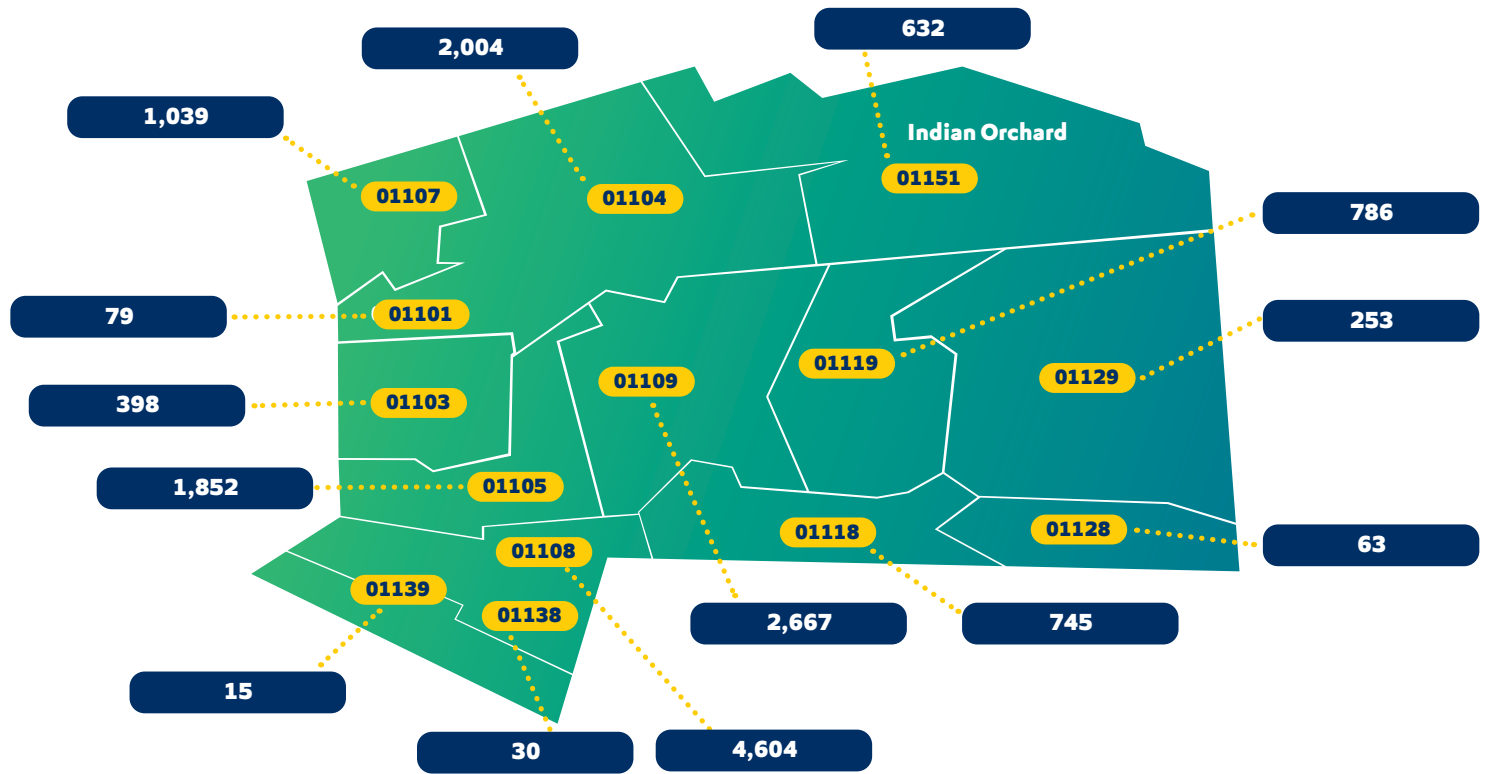
Healthcare Navigators

Choosing the right health insurance can be challenging due to complex terminology, cost considerations, network restrictions, numerous options, and changing healthcare needs. To address this, five full-time, highly trained Navigators at Caring Health Center guide patients through the process. “Our team is very skilled in what they do,” said Erica Letson, Project Manager for Outreach & Enrollment. “Some of our Navigators have been with us for 20 years.” The team relies on both experience and extensive annual training and recertification. Funded by the Massachusetts Health Connector, Navigators provide free services to the public, not just CHC patients. They assist with enrollment in Health Connector and MassHealth insurance plans and refer to other options as needed.

For Medicare applications, individuals are directed to the Social Security office. Since Medicare B covers only 80% of costs, Navigators help apply for MassHealth as secondary insurance or refer to a SHINE counselor for supplemental plans. SHINE assists those with Medicare A & B in finding additional coverage. Enrollment assistance is available to all, including longtime residents, newly arrived refugees, individuals, and families. Navigators also conduct extensive community outreach to raise awareness of available services and insurance options. In 2025, they made 4,552 individual assists. The demand for assistance remains high.
